Schedule, Guidelines, and Procedures.

Show day schedule

Thursday, June 25, 2020

8:00a.m.	Arrival of dairy cattle begins
10:30a.m.	Showmanship begins (senior, intermediate, junior)
Noon	Cows classes, heifer classes follow

- 🐾 Milk house will be available to milk after cows are done being shown.
- 🐾 Please have your animal ready to show. We will not stop the show or wait if you are not ready to bring your animal in the show ring.
- 🐾 Once the show is finished you will be asked to clean up and leave the fair grounds.

- 🐾 Refer to the 2020 Elroy Fair Procedures and Recommendations for COVID for details and complete fair procedures at ElroyFair.com
- 🐾 Due to the COVID situation, the dairy show is not open to the public. We are trying to limit the number of people on site to only those necessary for each show. We will be live streaming the show. Stay tuned to see where those at home can view the show
- 🐾 Schedule and guidelines are subject to change. Please check for updates on our Facebook page [ElroyFair-Wisconsin](https://www.facebook.com/ElroyFair-Wisconsin).
- 🐾 Once the show is finished please clean up after yourself and leave the fair grounds. If you brought anything in that makes trash, please take it home with you.
- 🐾 Please be smart and respectful of others and their health. If you have a cough, fever, shortness of breath, sore throat or any other symptoms STAY HOME. Social distance to the best of your abilities. Wash hands often! We have the right to ask anyone to leave the grounds if we feel you are not practicing social distancing the best you can throughout the show.
- 🐾 **Wearing face masks is strongly recommended.**

Show day Check-in

- 🐾 The **Animal Identification Form** needs to be filled out prior to arriving the grounds! You will not be able to unload without it! This can be found on the Elroy Fair website or on Fair Entry site at registration.
- 🐾 If you are showing a registered animal make sure you have your papers ready upon arrival.
- 🐾 We need to make check in fast and simple. We need your help and preparation to make this go smooth so that we can get the show going.
- 🐾 There will be no Early Age or PeeWee Showmanship this year.

Clipping

- 🐾 Please bring your animals clipped and top lines ready, if applicable. You will have time on show day to blow up a top line if you come prepared.
- 🐾 There will be no full body or leg clipping at the fairgrounds.
- 🐾 You can do some small touch ups to top lines

Washing

- 🐾 Please do a full wash of your animals prior to arriving.
- 🐾 You can wash off your animal once you arrive after trailering, but this will be a quick wash to just remove what happened on the trailer.
- 🐾 Limit your time at the wash rack when you arrive. We will be limiting the amount of people at the wash rack at a time. Please wash and remove your animal right away to keep areas open.

Stalling

- 🐾 You will be contacted after entries close to see if you would like to tie in a barn or if you will be showing out of a trailer.
- 🐾 If you will be tying in the barn you may bring bedding. Please keep this to a minimum, it will need to be cleaned up right away.
- 🐾 If you will be bringing feed, please keep this to a minimum as well.

Tack:

- 🐾 Try to keep this to a minimal as well. If you don't need it, keep it home.
- 🐾 There will be no show boxes or decorations.

Reminders

- 🐾 You will be responsible for cleaning up any mess you make, this includes bedding, feed, and garbage.
- 🐾 The milk house is new this year. **Please be respectful** to all the equipment inside and outside the milk house.
- 🐾 We will provide a bucket of sanitizer to use on the milkers.

- 🐾 **Most importantly have fun!! With the given circumstance this year, we hope you can still have the same fun that you do every year.**
