Obedience classes

- Due to the COVID situation, the dog show is not open to the public. We are trying to limit the number of people on site to only those necessary for each show. We will be live streaming the show. Stay tuned to see where those at home can view the show

- Once the show is finished please clean up after yourself and leave the fair grounds. If you brought anything in that makes trash, please take it home with you.
- Please be smart and respectful of others and their health. If you have a cough, fever, shortness of breath, sore throat or any other symptoms STAY HOME. Social distance to the best of your abilities. Wash hands often! We have the right to ask anyone to leave the grounds if we feel you are not practicing social distancing the best you can throughout the show.

## **Entry**

Because county 4-H dog training classes could not be held you may enter the class you showed in last year.

## Show day

- Social distancing will be observed. Please arrange your chairs 6 feet apart.
- **Wearing face masks is strongly recommended.**
- Since dogs have not had the normal socializing with county 4-H practices this year, please social distance your dogs as well to avoid confrontations.
- Check in when you arrive and maintain social distancing while waiting to show.
- Please have your dog ready to enter the ring. We will not stop the show or wait if you are not ready to bring your animal in the show ring.
- The judge will practice social distancing in the show ring.
- Ribbons and awards will be laid out to be picked up after judging by the exhibitor or their family. No ribbons will be mailed.
- Most importantly have fun!! With the given circumstances this year, we hope you can still have the same fun that you do every year.
