Livestock Shows Schedule, Guidelines, and Procedures

Show Schedule

Friday, June 26, 2020

8:00-9:30a.m.	Beef arrival and weigh-in. DO NOT ARRIVE EARLY.
10:00 a.m	Beef showmanship: Senior, Intermediate, Junior, Beginner Breed classes Market classes
3:00-4:00 p.m.	Goat arrival and weigh-in. DO NOT ARRIVE EARLY.
4:30p.m.	Goat Showmanship: Senior, Intermediate, Junior Milking goats Other breed classes Market classes

Saturday, June 27, 2020

8:00-9:00 a.m.	Hog arrival and weigh-in. DO NOT ARRIVE EARLY.
9:30a.m.	Swine Showmanship: Senior, Intermediate, Junior Market classes
10:30a.m.-noon	Sheep arrival and weigh-in. DO NOT ARRIVE EARLY.
12:30 p.m.	Sheep showmanship: Senior, Intermediate, Junior Market classes Breed classes
5:30p.m.	Beef, goats, poultry, and rabbits in auction return to grounds
6:00 p.m.	Championship Livestock Auction

- 🚫 Due to the COVID situation, the livestock shows are not open to the public. We are trying to limit the number of people on site to only those necessary for each show. We will be live streaming the show. Stay tuned to see where those at home can view the show
- 🚫 Once the show is finished please clean up after yourself and leave the fair grounds. If you brought anything in that makes trash, please take it home with you.
- 🚫 Please be smart and respectful of others and their health. If you have a cough, fever, shortness of breath, sore throat or any other symptoms STAY HOME. Social distance to the best of your abilities. Wash hands often! We have the right to ask anyone to leave the grounds if we feel you are not practicing social distancing the best you can throughout the show.
- 🚫 **Wearing face masks is strongly recommended.**

Show day Check-in

- 🚫 **Have your paperwork ready. You may be asked to pull out of line if you are not prepared.** We need to make check-in fast and simple. We need your help and preparation to make this go smoothly so that we can get the show going.
- 🚫 The **Animal Identification Form** needs to be filled out prior to arriving on the grounds! You will not be able to unload without it! This can be found on the Elroy Fair website www.Elroyfair.com or Fair Entry.
- 🚫 Hogs still need a **Veterinary Health Certificate** prior to coming off the trailer. You will not be permitted to show without the certificate. Hogs should also be tagged prior to arrival on the grounds.
- 🚫 If you are showing a registered animal make sure you have your **registration papers** ready upon arrival.
- 🚫 If the animal's current tag is legible, then they should not need an additional tag (unless there are duplicates).

Show day schedule

- 🐾 Schedule and guidelines are subject to change. Please check for updates on our Facebook page ElroyFair-Wisconsin. We will try to stick as close to it as we are able.
- 🐾 Please have your animal ready to show. We will not stop the show or wait if you are not ready to bring your animal in the show ring.
- 🐾 Once the show is finished you will be asked to clean up and leave the fair grounds. There will be **NO** animals or people staying at the grounds overnight.
- 🐾 There will be no Early Age or PeeWee Showmanship this year.

Washing

- 🐾 Please do a full wash of your animals prior to arriving.
- 🐾 You can wash off your animal once you arrive after trailering, but this will be a quick wash to just remove what happened on the trailer.
- 🐾 Limit your time at the wash rack when you arrive. Please wash and remove your animal right away to keep areas open. Try to keep social distancing guidelines in mind.

Fitting

- 🐾 We are strongly encouraging a no fit/blow and go show. You should have some time to work on fitting animals, but as in any other year, we will not hold a class up to wait for someone fitting an animal. We will try to move classes along.

Stalling

- 🐾 It is encouraged to show “from the trailer” when possible. The exception to this may be hogs. Typically it is easier to show from pen.
- 🐾 However, the barns are available for use if so desired. We will not assign any stalls. Again, please follow social distancing guidelines in the barns.
- 🐾 If you will be tying in the barn you may bring bedding. Please keep this to a minimum, it will need to be cleaned up right away.
- 🐾 If you will be bringing feed, please keep this to a minimum as well.

Tack

- 🐾 Try to keep this to a minimal as well. If you don't need it, keep it home.
- 🐾 There will be no decorations.

Auction

- 🐾 **NO** animals will be housed overnight. Therefore, any rabbits, poultry, beef or goats that will be on the auction on Saturday night, will need to return on Saturday by approximately 5:30pm. Since we are working on a more fluid schedule, if there are exhibitors showing sheep that need to return animals home and then return with one of the other species, we will try to do our best to have them listed later in the sale order.
