- Once the show is finished please clean up after yourself and leave the fair grounds. If you brought anything in that makes trash, please take it home with you.

- You may keep your cages in your vehicle or a trailer or social distance at least six feet apart from the next group in the Weber Pavilion.
- Common judging tables will not be used to avoid cross contamination.
- Please have your animal ready to show. We will not stop the show or wait if you are not ready to bring your animal in the show ring.
- Rabbit Exhibitors:** Bring a grooming table, carpet remnant or other table or surface to show your rabbit on. These will be placed at a proper location for social distancing and the judge will visit each entry individually.

- Poultry Exhibitors:** Please provide your own table and material for footing. If you have a cage that would work for judging on your table, please bring it. These will be placed at a proper location for social distancing and the judge will visit each entry individually.
